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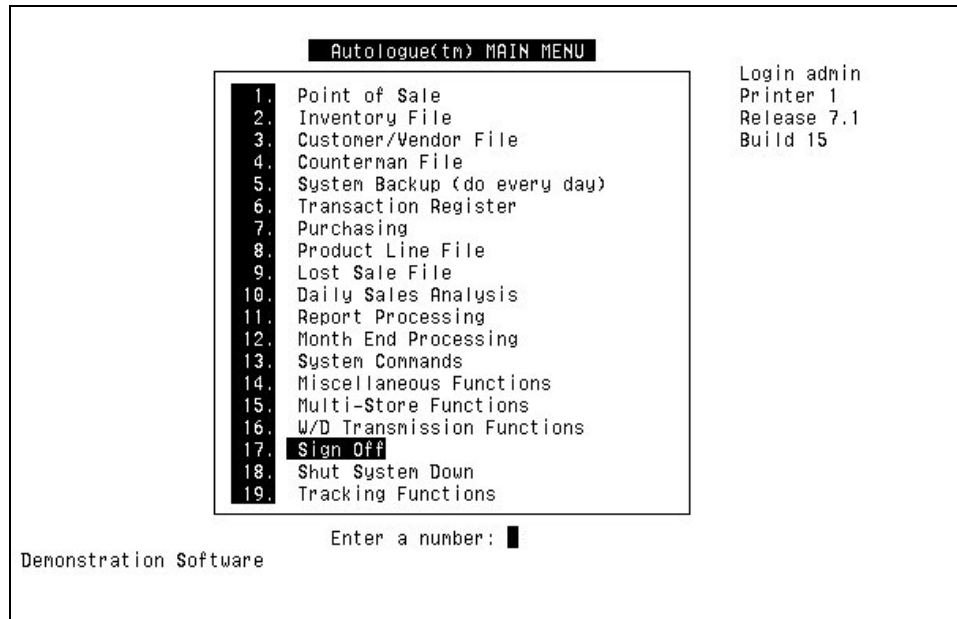
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1. Introduction

Since 1979, the name Autologue has been associated with supplying computer solutions in both retail and wholesale businesses by offering a sophisticated, yet easy to use, integrated and multi-user point of sale package.

Using an integrated point of sale, the constant need to batch customer A/R details and inventory sales is completely eliminated. Being multi-user allows your system to perform several functions all at the same time.



This chapter of the user's manual will introduce and highlight various features of the Autologue Computer System, including multi-store and warehouse order transmission communications.

1.1 Product Description

The Autologue system is a menu driven point of sale package designed to be a powerful and easy to use management tool. Creating and finalizing invoices automatically updates customer and inventory files, allowing statements to be generated, purchase orders to be developed and management analysis to be performed.

Listed below are several of the Autologue standard features:

- Supports multiple users and multi-tasking functions at the same time
- Tracks 24 months of sales and profit by customer and product line
- Automatically posts customer A/R details through point of sale invoicing

- Automatically posts inventory sales and adjusts quantity on hand through point of sale
- Tracks seven quarters of sales history by part number
- Develops purchase orders based upon four different methods
- Tracks sales, profit and price overrides by counterperson
- Tracks profitability by invoice and line item
- Tracks lost sales, special orders and customer backorders by part number and customer
- Prints management reports in flexible, user defined formats
- Includes password protection and extensive file integrity check and backup/restore facilities

1.2 Multi-Store Capabilities

Multi-Store communications supports a centralized configuration of branch stores.

In a centralized configuration, one central computer is operated in the host store, with each branch store installing terminals and printers connected to the host's computer via modems, multiplexors and telephone lines.

In both configurations the following functions are available:

- Remote part look up and transfer of merchandise between stores
- Consolidated daily sales analysis report, by store and for all stores
- Consolidated purchase orders and fill from host store's inventory
- Consolidated statements of common customers
- Centralized inventory control
- Communication status logs
- Password protection and security

1.3 Warehouse/Transnet Order Communications

Through warehouse order communications, purchase orders can be transmitted electronically to a supplier supporting standard protocols and formats for electronic order transmission.

Using electronic order transmission the following protocols and formats are supported:

- Asynchronous communications protocol
- 2780 bisynchronous communications protocol
- 3780 bisynchronous communications protocol
- Initiated transmission of an order
- Triad order format
- Autologue order format
- Parts data format
- Transnet order format
